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1. Read carefully the Instructions for authors.¹
 2. Prepare your LaTeX manuscript, using the template as a guide.²
 3. Before 18 July, 2016, upload a pdf version of your proposed paper to the journal website- see below for complete instructions.
- If you wish the editors to advise on English, please submit the paper by 13 June.
4. After you receive the referee reports, and assuming your paper is accepted, make any necessary changes, and upload again.

Some key points are the following.

- _ Your paper must be no more than ten A4 pages in length. If you need a longer paper, then submit as a regular article to ANZIAM J(e) (not to the special part for ANZIAM-ZPAMS).
 - _ Before you can submit your paper, you must register with the ANZIAM Journal as both an Author and a Reviewer , or already be registered.
 - _ Each author who submits a paper must agree to referee up to two other papers. A paper may be declined if an author declines to review allocated papers.
 - _ All referee reports must be uploaded before 8 August, 2016.
- The journal will apply its normal standards on originality and quality of submissions.
- _ The journal strictly enforces its Instructions for authors, and reserves the right to return to authors poorly presented material for appropriate revision, or even to reject a paper on TeXnical grounds".

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Prepare pdf , normally 10 pages maximum, 12pt, A4, 14 cm text width.
